

Daily Inspection

- All slabs in the yard/warehouse are in a safe storage location and all broken slabs are secure at all times.
- All slab isles inside, outside and in between slabs are cleared of trash and debris.
- All ladders used to re-assemble open top containers are in good/safe condition.
- All A-Frames used to store slabs and transport slabs on our trucks are in good/safe loading condition without wear. Focus on all weld joints, footings, etc...
- Slab boom lift cables and hooks are in good working condition.
- Slab boom forklifts are kept clean and clear of trash and tools.
- Slab boom forklifts are inspected at the beginning of every shift to ensure safe operation. Proper paperwork must be completed at the beginning of every shift.
- Slab yard/warehouse staff wears steel toe boots that are in good condition.
- Slab yard/warehouse staff working outside wears clothing, sunscreen, etc. to protect them from the elements.
- All trash bins are emptied frequently and slab customer areas are kept clean at all times.
- Radios should not be played during business hours except from appropriate overhead music that is controlled by management.

At time of use:

- All hand tools are in safe working condition, especially electric handsaws.
- Slab yard/warehouse staff wears hand, ear and eye protection and keeps gear in good condition.

Immediately:

- All excess wood, especially pieces with nails should be cleared and thrown away immediately.
- All open crates and loose slabs without straps have "Do Not Lean Slabs" signs on them.
